<input type="checkbox"/> Fulfill Health Insurance Requirement (CSU requires domestic students taking six or more resident instruction credits, and international students enrolled at any level, to have health insurance)	By Wednesday, September 8, 2021	Domestic Graduate students enrolled in six (6) or more credits: Go to health.colostate.edu/insurancerequirement to access the secure online health insurance waiver portal. You must take action to either WAIVE or ENROLL in the Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) by the deadline, or your student account will be charged for the cost of SHIP enrollment. Domestic Graduate students enrolled in LESS than six (6) credits: You may voluntarily enroll in the Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) by completing an online enrollment form at health.colostate.edu/enroll-ship and agreeing to pay the health access and counseling fees. International Graduate students enrolled at any level: International students are automatically enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP). If you have other health insurance coverage, visit health.colostate.edu/international-into-waiver for more information on how to submit a waiver request. 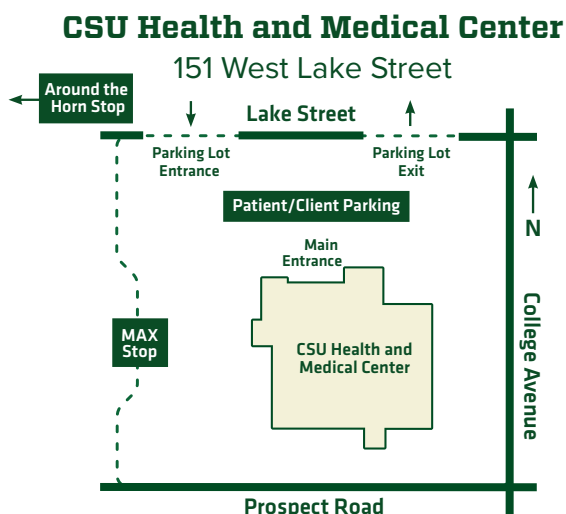
