SUBMIT AN ABSTRACT EARLY

The call for proposals for the in-person 2023 GradShow will close once capacity is reached or by Oct. 5. **The first students to submit an abstract will have their choice** of presenting during the GREEN session from 9:30-11:30 a.m. or the GOLD session from 10:30-12:30 p.m., should their abstract be accepted. All performing arts presentations are scheduled by the GradShow committee.
